Short Message

Disruptive rain is leading to flooding in places is expected over the south-eastern parts of Limpopo and eastern high-veld and escarpment of Mpumalanga.

Discussion

Cut-off low over the south-western parts of the country resulting in disruptive rainfall in places over Mpumalanga, Limpopo and the Western Cape.

Impacts

- Flooding of roads and settlements (formal and informal), and possible damage to roads and bridges
- Danger to life (fast flowing streams / deep water)
- Some communities temporarily not accessible/cut-off (especially those surrounded by rivers and streams)

Instruction

If possible stay indoors and off the roads, avoid crossing rivers and swollen streams where water is above your ankles. If trapped in a vehicle during a flood, abandon it and climb to higher ground. In buildings, move valuables to a safe place above the expected flood level.
